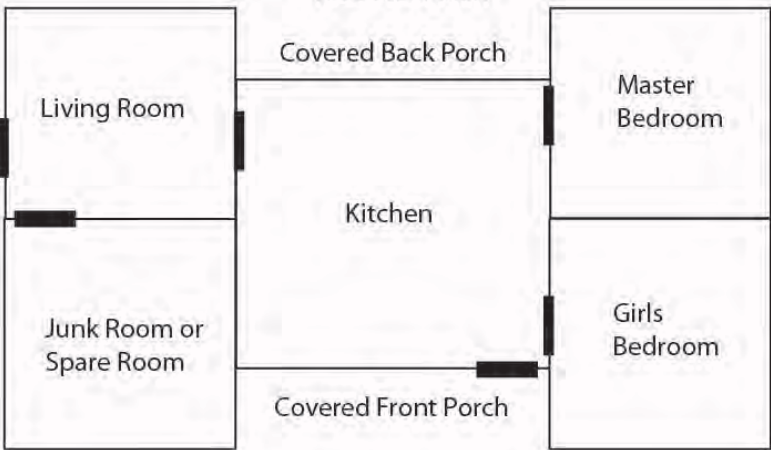

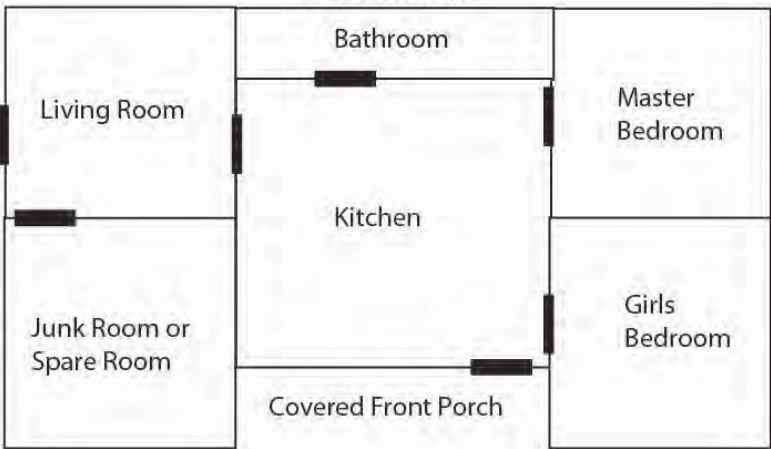
Richmond Home
